An Employment Authorization Document (EAD) is an identification card that U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) issues to certain qualifying foreign nationals to work in the U.S. Many people refer to the card as a work permit. At USCIS, the Employment Authorization Document is known as Form I-766. The EAD card contains a photograph of the individual authorized to work and may include the individual's fingerprint.

Foreign nationals in certain employment eligibility categories who file Form I-765, Application for Employment Authorization, to renew their EADs may receive automatic extensions of their expiring EAD for up to 180 days. The extension begins on the date the EAD expires and continues for up to 180 days, unless USCIS denies the renewal application. An automatic EAD extension depends on these requirements:

4.4 Automatic Extensions of Employment Authorization ...

DHS will automatically extend EADs (Form I-766) for employees with certain EAD category codes who timely file to renew their EAD. An automatic extension also may apply if USCIS cannot issue a new EAD before the expiration date of a previous EAD, which sometimes occurs for individuals with Temporary Protected Status.

Employment Authorization Document Codes. Agencies verifying eligibility of applicants for benefits are frequently presented with an I-766 Employment Authorization Document (EAD). To assist agencies in determining the applicant's eligibility, the following chart contains many of the EAD category codes and the provisions of the federal regulations to which they refer.

Certain aliens who are in the United States may file Form I-765, Application for Employment Authorization, to request employment authorization and an Employment Authorization Document (EAD). Other aliens whose immigration status authorizes them to work in the United States without restrictions may also use Form I-765 to apply to U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) for an EAD that shows such authorization.

Employment Authorization Card Category Codes. USCIS issues an EAD card for unrestricted employment in the USA. The EAD card is also known as form I-766. The application form name EAD card is called form I-765. Form I765 requires an EAD category code to judge your eligibility.

The EAD card (Form I-765) is required as proof of employment eligibility before joining work with an employer in the US. USCIS made this adjustment to the rule of needing a list C document for Form I-9, Employment Eligibility Verification compliance until Dec. 1, 2020.

Foreign nationals who are temporarily residing in the U.S. and are eligible to work may file an application for a work permit and receive an EAD (Employment Authorization Document). Permanent residents or Green Card holders don't require an EAD to work.
