### Factors associated with self-assessed work ability.

The result is also similar to that obtained by Van den Berg et al. , who identified the factors associated with poor work ability to be older age, lack of leisure time, lack of vigorous physical activity, poor musculoskeletal capacity, obesity, high physical and psychosocial work demands, poor physical work environment, and high physical workload [7, 24].

Factors highly correlated with greater work ability included greater self-efficacy in performing self-cares, lower physical load on the neck at work, greater self-reported chance of being able to work in 6 months' time, greater use of active coping strategies, lower frequency of hand weakness, and higher health-related quality of life.

Multiple regression identified younger age, being employed and a faster timed up and down stairs test as significant independent factors associated with work ability ( $r^2 = 0.333$ ,  $p < 0.001$ ). Conclusions Reference data can be used to identify individuals with low work ability.

Work ability refers to a worker's job-related functional capacity, or a worker's ability to continue working in his or her current job, given the challenges or demands of the job and his or her resources (Ilmarinen, Gould, Järvikoski, & Järvisalo, 2008).Ilmarinen and colleagues at the Finnish Institute of Occupational Health (FIOH) first introduced the construct of work ability to the ...

### Individual and Work Factors Related to Perceived Work ...

To be younger than 40 at the time of the surgery was associated with a higher probability to return to work ( $p < .001$ ). Multivariable regression analysis showed that patient age < 40 years as well as occupational group and self-reported fatigue were factors independently associated with the ability to return to work.

### The ability to return to work: a patient-centered outcome ...

Seven factors explained 65% (adjusted  $R^2 = 0.65$ ,  $p < 0.01$ ) of the variance in work ability. In descending order of strength of association, these factors are: greater neck disability due to pain; reduced self-rated health status and health-related quality of life; increased frequency of concentration problems; poor workplace satisfaction; lower self-efficacy for performing daily tasks; and greater work-related stress.

### Factors associated with work ability in patients with ...

We identified factors at the individual, unit-based work level and the organizational level associated with work ability. Individual factors that were protective included teamwork, and feeling healthy and capable of doing their job. Unit-based level work factors included having a schedule that accommodated work-life balance, and one's chronotype promoted work ability. Organizational factors included management that valued worker's voice supported work ability.
